



Sleep in the original convent of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Concordia, Kansas. Eat supper and breakfast with the Sisters who live there now. Learn about the history and architecture of both this building, now the Manna House of Prayer spiritual retreat center, and the current Motherhouse that dominates the landscape in this small north central Kansas city. And talk with the Sisters themselves about how “religious life” has evolved over the past 125+ years.



In the morning, you’ll have a hearty Kansas breakfast and then a tour of the current Motherhouse, built in 1902 and now listed on the National Register of Historic Places. There you’ll learn more about the history of the congregation and the architecture of the five-story Nazareth Convent and Academy as well as its current use as a residence for Sisters, plus view some of the works of art and artifacts that are the heritage of the Sisters of St. Joseph. Weather permitting, you’ll also have time to walk through Lourdes Park and the Grotto on the beautiful Motherhouse grounds.
